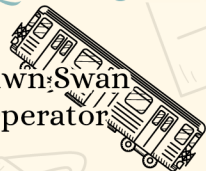

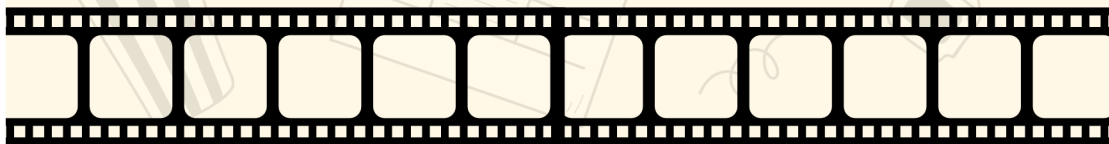
Our mission is to enrich the community through music and performing arts while fostering an environment in which members can express their creativity and grow as artists. We are so excited to be performing this show for you!


